#### When is the event?

### What are the volunteer shifts?

## What will I be doing and where do I show up?

- We will email you at least one week before the event with a description of your volunteer role.
- You will have an orientation when you arrive so you know what you will be doing!

  - We'll have extra waivers on site
- o If you are under 18, your parents must sign it.
