Frequently Asked Questions

When is the event?

- The event is on Saturday, June 1st from 10am to 3pm at Peavy Arboretum ([located here](#))

What are the volunteer shifts?

- We offer three volunteer shift options in the [registration](#):
 - Morning: 9am to 12:30pm
 - Afternoon: 12-3:30pm
 - All day: 9am to 3:30pm

What will I be doing and where do I show up?

- All volunteers will report to Peavy Arboretum to sign in ([located here](#))
- We will email you at least one week before the event with a description of your volunteer role.
- You will have an orientation when you arrive so you know what you will be doing!

Do I need to sign anything?

- Yes! All volunteers must sign a waiver of liability before the event.
 - We'll send out a reminder and link to sign the form before the event
 - We'll have extra waivers on site
- If you are under 18, your parents must sign it.

What should I wear and bring?

- You will be outside rain or shine! We suggest bringing:
 - Comfortable walking shoes and long pants
 - Sunscreen, hats or rain gear.
 - Water bottle, any personal items you need

Do I need to bring a lunch?

- We will provide a sandwich lunch, snacks, and refreshments for all volunteers - because you rock!
- You will also get a snazzy Get Outdoors Day volunteer shirt to keep forever!
